Welcome to the 2009 Run for the Roses. The premier girls' hoops exposure event in the Midwest!!

We have done our best to take into account as many schedule requests as possible. But we have teams coming from 20 different states and 2 teams from Canada. Be sure to check the brackets up until Monday, July 6th for schedule updates.

Team check in will be at the Kentucky Basketball Academy (KBA) on Thursday, July 9th from 8:00am – 8:00pm and Friday July 10th from 8:00am – 8:00pm. Coaches and teams will pick up their tournament information packets at this time. Also the NCAA requires all participants to view an informational video about NCAA certified events and some of the rules and regulations that go along with participation. Included in the team information packet will contain a schedule of viewing times for your team to watch the video. EVERY PARTICIPANT MUST ATTEND A NCAA VIDEO SESSION! Each team must also provide one table operator either to operate the scoreboard or to record the official tournament score sheet.

This tournament falls within the eligible viewing period for NCAA D-I universities to watch players. Under NCAA guidelines coaches CANNOT, have interaction with players, parents or coaches. There should be no contact between players, parents, or team coaches with coaches/scouts from universities. College coaches are expected to follow all signage and congregate/watch games in designated areas. There will be separate entrances for participants and collegiate coaches as well.

We will use 5 different facilities for this tournament: Kentucky Basketball Academy, Georgetown College, Scott County High School, Scott County Ninth Grade School, Georgetown Middle School, and Royal Spring Middle School. Addresses and directions can be found on the tournament website.

Tournament t-shirts will be sold in the concession areas at all facilities for \$10 apiece.
